

Irrigation time, hay season and wheat season

Please remember to look up for power lines when laying out that irrigation pipe. We talked about maintenance of your power units in June and you might want to review that. Also check all electrical wiring for possible mice damage in panel boxes and on pivots. It's a good practice to have your pivot service people come and inspect your pivots.

As far as hay and wheat season, probably the biggest problem is the weather and having to wait on dry conditions. Trying to rush the crop only causes more problems and you all know about that. Also remember the danger of combine engine fires because of wheat chaff buildup in equipment; it's a good idea to periodically blow out the chaff that accumulates near the engine.
