

Regular equipment maintenance routine

In order to protect your equipment investment, one of the most crucial things you can do is have a regular maintenance schedule. Inside an engine, heat and contamination causes motor oil to lose its lubricating properties and oil filters clog up. You should change your oil and oil filter while they are still in good condition. When servicing all your ag and industrial machines keep the following in mind:

- Be sure and refer to the owners manual on the proper oils used in the engine, transmission and hydraulic systems, as well as the fluid that goes in your cooling system.
- The most neglected oil on a tractor is the MFD oil. Make sure it is checked regularly and changed annually.
- The 3-point hitch and MFD grease zerks are often overlooked. A low-dollar tube of grease can save thousands of dollars in costly repairs.
